- ❖ All applications are due by **May 20, 2010**. Applications and all required supporting documents should be mailed to Coastal Bryan Tree Foundation Scholarship, P. O. Box 2520, Richmond Hill, GA, 31324. Attn: Scholarship Award
- ❖ The recipient must reside in the household (primary residence) of a residence in Bryan County.
- ❖ The recipient must be enrolled upon awarding of scholarship in an accredited 4-year college or Baccalaureate program, either full-time or part-time.
- ❖ The grant is for undergraduate work only, preferably in one of the following fields of study: horticulture, biology, environmental science, forestry, agriculture or environmental design.
- ❖ The competition is open to high school students, as well as college and technical school students with a minimum 2.5 GPA.
- ❖ A person may submit an application each year.
- ❖ The scholarship fund will be \$500 to the scholarship winner.
- ❖ Scholarship use must commence within one year of date of issuance and be used within two years of the date of issuance.
- ❖ Scholarship criteria are as follows:
 - Volunteerism (20%)
 - Extra-Curricular activities (20%)
 - Academic Achievement (20%)
 - Innovation (20%) and
 - 250 word essay (20%)
- ❖ A committee of judges will review the applications. A recommendation will be forwarded to the Coastal Bryan Tree Foundation, which shall make the final decision. All decisions are final.
- ❖ The Coastal Bryan Tree Foundation Board of Directors administers Scholarship.
- ❖ Winners for the Coastal Bryan Tree Foundation Scholarship will be announced June 1st.
